Junior School Administration and Classroom Construction

School Fees

- If you have not yet received your school fee Tax Invoice, please contact the Finance Office at accounts@tyndale.sa.edu.au and a copy will be issued.
- School Fees are due by Friday 12 February 2021 (Week 2) unless an instalment arrangement has been agreed with the School.
- Payment for the full year attracts a 4% discount on the tuition component providing the account is paid in full by the above due date.
- Application forms for School Card assistance are now available on the School Card website and parents are encouraged to complete the online form. Paper copies will be available from the Main Administration Office if you are unable to submit an online form. Parents must re-apply for school card each year and this needs to be done in Term 1.

Uniform Shop

All families need to make an appointment before visiting the Uniform Shop. Please also note that the Uniform Shop is unable to accept cash at this point in time.

The School Uniform Shop is located in the Senior School in Block 2. Please refer to the School website for opening hours as hours will vary during school holiday periods. We also have an online uniform shop which parents can access. If you have not used the online uniform shop, you will need to set up an account as follows:

2. Select "Tyndale Christian School" under the Online School Shops menu
3. Click "Register New Account"
4. The School Passphrase is "Tyndale1983"
5. Add your personal information
6. Order the items you require, select pick up in store or home delivery.

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Cafeteria – New Ordering Platform

During Term 1, we will be ceasing our relationship with QuickCliq and will be rolling out a new app for lunch orders. The advantages of Qkr! are:

1. No need to load money in advance;
2. No fees payable by parents; and;
3. Manage your child's cafe orders to ensure they are eating well.

Simply download the Qkr! app from the App store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android) and select Tyndale Christian School Salisbury East. From here, you will be able to set up your children's profiles in readiness for their first order! The Café will commence processing orders from Week 1. Orders will need to be placed by 8:35am.

For families that have a balance on QuickCliq, please log into your account and on your Profile page there is an option to "Request Refund". Please complete this information and all funds will be returned to your nominated account.

Stationery

Stationery packs will be provided to each student along with diaries and timetables. Book covers to protect the exercise books may also be provided as part of the pack, if required. Students will be required to provide a pencil case.

Siren Familiarisation

During Week 1, the School will run a siren familiarisation session on Wednesday morning. All students will be required to stay in their classrooms to hear the difference between the three sirens (evacuation, lock in and all clear) and for staff to talk through what we do. An evacuation drill will be held in the middle of Term 1, and a letter will be issued to parents prior to the event.

Medical Information

Medication will not be issued to any student without a current medical action plan or notification from a medical practitioner for its specific use.

Medication must be provided to the Health Care Centre in its original purchase container, with dosage equipment if required. A pharmacy label attached to prescribed medicine provided by a doctor or pharmacist that clearly identifies the student, dosage, frequency and used-by details is acceptable.

If the medical information for your children has changed, please advise the Health Care Centre as soon as possible.
