This letter provides further detail about arrangements for online learning for Year 10 and 11 students in Week 10.

Zoom Lessons

Teachers will provide Zoom lessons in two or three of their lessons in each subject over the four days of next week. The roll will be taken at each of these lessons; 'attendance' at these Zoom lessons is compulsory. Zoom times will be indicated via subject Canvas pages where Zoom links will also be provided. It will be the responsibility of students to check these carefully to ensure that they are accessing the learning available. In addition, every Year 10 and 11 student will have Zoom lessons in their regular Monday lessons at 8.45am and again at 10.15am on Monday.

Where a student does not have a scheduled Zoom lesson, they will be able to access resources on Canvas and continue with their own learning. It is vital that students use their time well next week. Assignment due dates for next week remain in place

Children of Critical Workers


During our Senior School online learning in Week 10, we understand that for families of critical workers there may be an ongoing need for us to provide supervision of your son/daughter.
