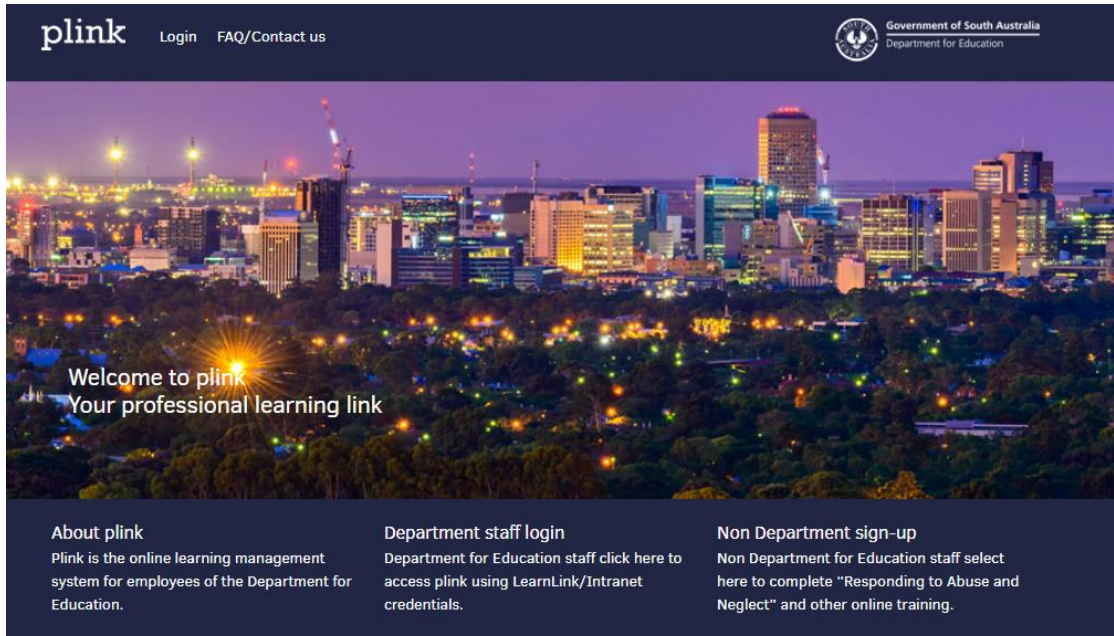

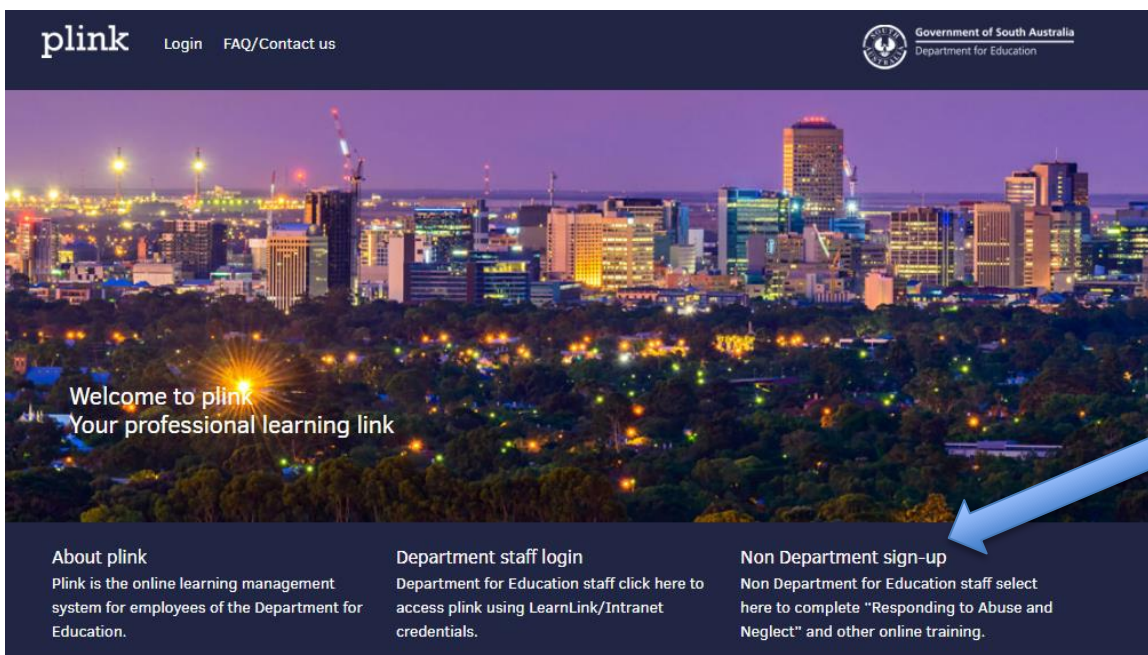


RAN-EC 2018-2020 update course has expired


The RAN-EC 2018-2020 online update course has expired, and is no longer available on plink. If you do not have a current RAN-EC certificate you must do the [foundation course](#).
If you are a teacher who is not currently employed, you can still sign up below to access the Teacher's registration renewal: RAN-EC 2018-2020 course. This allows you to maintain your registration with the Teacher's Registration Board, **but does not cover you for employment purposes**. How to create a plink account

If you do not currently work for the Department for Education or Department for Child Protection, this is where you can sign up to access training. Your account type assigns the courses you will have access to. It's important you select the right account type, so please have a look at the below table before you create an account.

Account type	Who for	What it gives you
Volunteer	Volunteers within the Education sector	Volunteers online course: RAN-EC General Induction White Ribbon training
Governing council member	Members of a governing council or preschool management committee (Department for Education)	Volunteers online course: RAN-EC School governing council resources
SA Catholic Schools	Staff working in Catholic Education South Australia (CESA)	Teacher's registration renewal: RAN-EC 2018-2020 NAPLAN Online training
SA Independent Schools	Staff working in Association of Independent Schools of South Australia (AISSA)	Teacher's registration renewal: RAN-EC 2018-2020 NAPLAN Online training
OSHC staff	Staff working in an out of school hours care service	Teacher's registration renewal: RAN-EC 2018-2020
CSE trained	Staff who have a current Child Safe Environments certificate	Child Safe Environments to RAN-EC bridging course
Other	Any person who does not fit in to the above categories but requires access to the Teacher's registration renewal: RAN-EC 2018-2020. This can include any teacher who is not currently working, but needs to keep their teacher's registration current.	Teacher's registration renewal: RAN-EC 2018-2020




