Playgroup

Our desire to identify gaps in the Early Education sector led us to launch the Tiny Tyndalians Playgroup. After chatting with the parents in our community, we found that the younger siblings of our children did not want to leave when dropping off their older siblings for their ELC day. In response to this, we identified that there was a need for another activity for these younger learners in Strathalbyn and opened the Tiny Tyndalians Playgroup.

Playgroup engages children from birth to preschool age (0-4) in a play-based learning environment. These sessions provide opportunities for early socialisation, enhancing your child's growth and development, providing connection and community for parents, and providing familiarity with the ELC and the School.

Playgroup is run by our ELC Education Support Office Shirley McCabe, and is held twice a week during school terms with the option of:

Monday 9:00am to 11:00am
Thursday 9:00am to 11:00am

In playgroup, children participate in indoor and outdoor play such as painting, craft, playdough, blocks, sandpit, nature play, obstacle course, ball games, home corner and puzzles. Plus, we run a short story and song time as a group at the end where children enjoy a fruit snack while listening to a story read to them by Mrs McCabe and then join in singing some action songs and nursery rhymes.
